

Attention Researchers Using IRB-02 and IRB-03
New required training goes into effect March 8, 2018

The University of Florida is pursuing AAHRPP Accreditation of our Human Research Protection Program (HRPP) and underwent an on-site inspection January 10-12, 2018. As part of that inspection, AAHRPP identified some deficiencies needing addressed, including an issue related to IRB related training. In order to meet AAHRPP requirements for IRB related training, the following training is required after March 8, 2018 (the new courses are highlighted).

After March 8, 2018, all research staff listed in the myIRB application must complete the required training listed above in order to submit any new studies.

Notes:

1. You can easily identify if any research staff have not completed their training in myIRB. On the top right side of the Study Workspace is the section "Pending Agreements to Participate". If a research staff name is here with **red font** then that individual has not completed all of the required training.
2. Training records can take 3-4 days to migrate from myTraining to myIRB. Please be sure to complete your training well in advance of any deadlines.
